

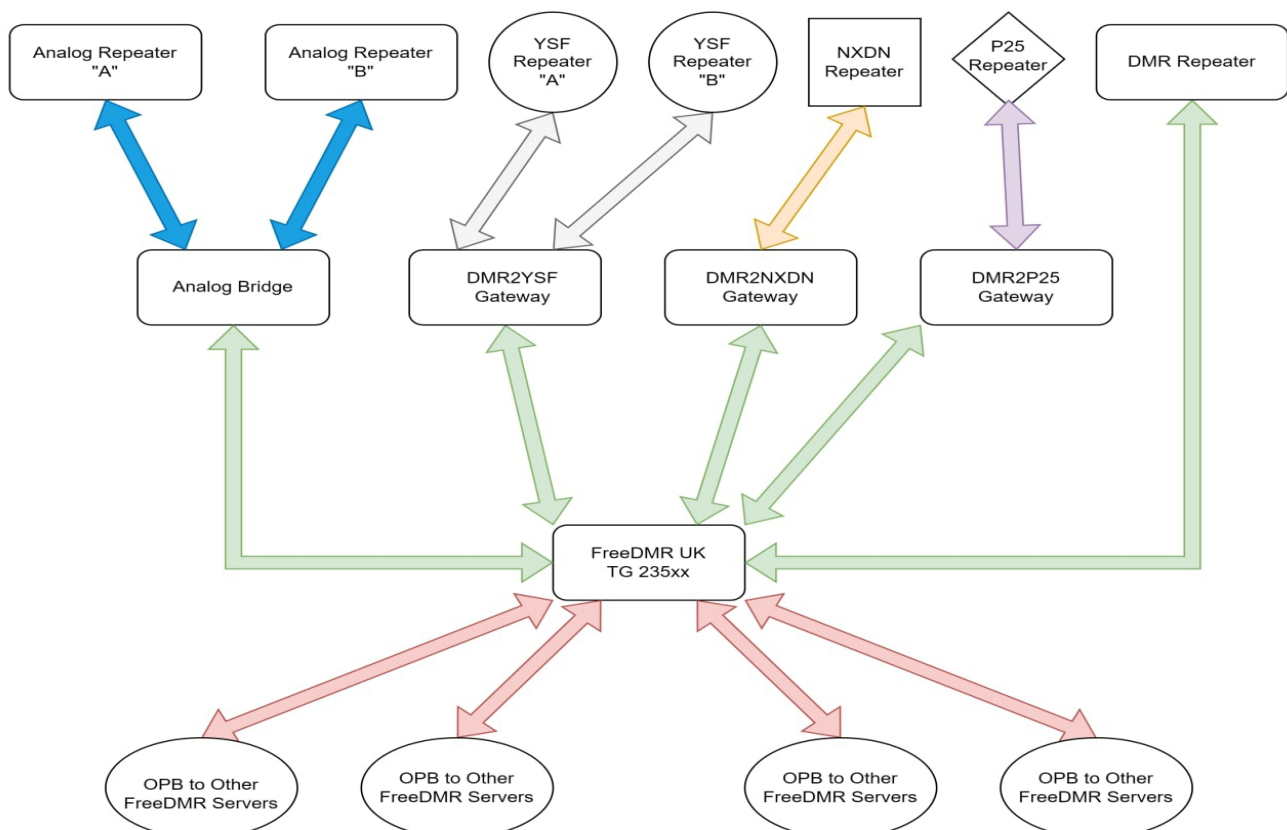


## Bridge to FreeDMR UK talk groups.

We welcome all types of Bridges  
 XLX, YSF, P25, NXDN, Allstar (ASL), WiresX, Echolink, TGIF etc

- You own the system that is to be bridged or have full consent from the owner.
- You have read this section on [bridges](#) and this document and agree.
- You will supply [architecture diagram](#) to show what your wanting to do if requested. *(This is a handy tool for making [diagrams.net](#))*

- Supply all relevant info. How you wish to connect the bridge, what software you are using, what protocol, what mode.
- You have the skill sets to run, manage the bridge.
- You have loop control in place.
- **Agree to -**

What FreeDMR UK Talk Group is to be bridged. (234xx or 235xx)

The Talk Group is to be a 5, 6 or 7 digit long.

If the Talk Group is to be named.

The use of the Talk Group and Bridge.

That the bridge is for all Ham Radio users with a valid licence.

If a bridge is more for personal/club use. The Talk Group will be your/club 6 or 7 digit ID number. Talk Group will not be named. Please read - [Personal Talk Group, Club/Group Talk Groups and Repeater Talk Group.](#)

Any changes to the bridge destination at your end, has to be pre approved by FreeDMR UK and all parties/networks involved.

- **If your bridge is in breach of -**

All rules that Govern Ham Radio and Licence apply.

All Laws on Computer Misuse act 1990 or Amendments Thereafter apply.

**FreeDMR UK reserves the Right to Limit or Revoke your bridge to the Service/Network. Without prior consultation.**

We encourage experimentation, we want to say yes, but that does not mean a free pass to do whatever you want. It's OK to ask questions before setting up a bridge and ask advice.

We accept that sometimes you need to build the system first then invite users, but we may want to ask what the bridge owner is going to do to encourage users. For example, give a talk at their radio club, invite existing amateur friends etc.
